AD's Reports

1. Discussed outside teams using our fields when available. Insurance covers anyone on property. Also discussed teams that are St. Albert parishioners but not St. Albert teams. They must use the name Vikings and not St. Albert Vikings and can not make reports in Bulletin.
2. We discussed the need for Coach Selection Guidelines. Robin and Donna will draft something up for discussion and next meeting. Would like it in place before volleyball tryouts in July.
3. Discussed the need for someone over the age of 21 being present at all practices which have head coaches that are 18 years of age but under the age of 21. There should always be more than one adult at practices.
4. Girls – Tennis – 6 kids went to City Tournament. Soccer – no complaints, going good. Field Hockey – 2 teams at each level. Tryouts current happening. Have coaches.
5. Boys – Pat Dalton is going to help Pat Callahan. Soccer – 8A is 3-0, 8B 2-1, 6B 3-0. Tournament starts June 5th. Trying to host 6B league tournament. Track – 7th & 8th Boys got 3rd place, 5th & 6th Boys 10th, 7th & 8th Girls 7th and 5th & 6th Girls placed 8th. Individual results – Boys 100yds Ben Tofaute 2nd, Michael Montano 3rd; Boys 220 Ben Tofaute 2nd; Boys 880 Alex Winrich 3rd; Boys High Jump Ben Tofaute 1st; Girls 60 Hurdle Theresa Montano 3rd. Donna Meyer mentioned that next year Pam Smith would like to help with track team and would like to enter more than just one meet.
6. Gym ceiling repair will begin immediately upon last day of school and will be done before volleyball tryouts. It will be a spring loaded drop ceiling.
7. Got quote from Farison for baseball field repair for \$10,000. If parishioners do some of the labor we could possibly get it done for \$3-5,000. Will add dirt for current season if possible.
